DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- What job would you like to have when you grow up? Why would you choose it?
- What would you like to know more about space, since reading this book?
- Would you like to go to space? How do you think it would feel to fly in a spaceship?
- What happened when the blue giant faded into dark?
- What emotions did you feel as you read this book?



ACTIVITIES

- An astronaut needs to be in good physical shape. What can you do to stay physically fit and healthy? Make an obstacle course to practice different skills like running, hopping, jumping jacks, push ups, somersaults, and more. What will your obstacle course include?
- Make plans for a trip to space! Invent your own space ship and draw it. Make
 a list of everything you would take on a space voyage. Don't forget to draw a
 map for your trip.
- If you could visit space and see a blue giant, what would it look like? Draw a picture! How would it feel in space? Are you in the picture?
